RESILIENCE IN ACTION:

Women Saving Lives Worldwide

From Africa to Australia, women are leading and inspiring within Destiny Rescue's network.

In Kenya, **Kioni**, our Project Manager (pictured in white), leads rescue efforts while providing a healing presence for children who have endured unimaginable cruelty. Orphaned in eighth grade, Kioni's life turned hopeful when Martha, her late mother's friend, offered her a home and support. Martha's compassion broke the cycle of exploitation that ensnared Kioni, allowing her to pursue an education and, ultimately, a career dedicated to rescuing children.



Today, Kioni stands beside young survivors, guiding them toward independence—gifts she once received through an act of kindness.

Joyce, our Business Manager in Kenya, leverages her expertise and life experience to provide survivors with education and employment opportunities, helping break the cycle of exploitation and ensuring children stay free. She says,

The (fact that) businesses... can sustain families and improve their life standards encourages and gives me hope at the end of the day."

Empowering Survivors Through Leadership

Invaluable Guidance from Survivors — Our Survivors Advisory Council, composed of resilient women who have triumphed over exploitation, is essential to our mission. Their lived experiences inform our strategies and ensure we deliver compassionate, impactful care that creates lasting change.



FRONTLINE DEFENCE:

Female Agents Intercepting Child Traffickers in Nepal



Our female agents in Nepal are among the most courageous defenders of children's rights. Positioned at crucial border sites, they work tirelessly to intercept traffickers and protect vulnerable children. Using specialised training, they establish trust with young girls who might hesitate to speak with male agents. By identifying suspicious behaviour, conducting interviews, and intervening, these agents stop trafficking attempts before they reach the border.



Dressed in their distinctive blue uniforms, our agents, stationed at strategic border locations, are highly trained to identify trafficking risks and intercept young girls deceived by traffickers' false promises. Hadara, a border agent driven by her commitment to end human trafficking, shared. "It is easy for me to counsel them." reflecting on how her experience as a woman helps her connect with survivors. Her colleagues, Bani and Farida, agree that being female allows them to better support and counsel rescued girls. Watching young survivors reunite with their families gives them purpose and fuels their passion.

Many victims were lured through online platforms, highlighting traffickers' evolving tactics. The quick action and dedication of our agents have saved countless lives. ensuring these children are spared from exploitation.

For every child Destiny Rescue reaches, there's a network of compassion and dedication, often sparked by a single person daring to make a difference. Agents like Kioni, Criselda, Samantha, and Joyce demonstrate that no matter how dark life may seem, hope can indeed light a way forward.

These women embody resilience, expertise, and compassion, offering hope and opportunity to those thev serve.

In 2024, Tracey walked 1,000 km from Brisbane to Sydney to raise funds to help rescue children!
